The best ideas were selected and business planning was done to facilitate the implementation of these ideas in a real business environment. Youth workers provided training and technical support to the trainees for the presentations.



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By the end of this activity, through the workshop and the evaluations of other social business ideas, participants gained a better understanding of the opportunities and challenges that can arise when developing an idea into a business and will be better equipped to make the best decisions regarding the projects they wish to implement. In addition, they have now access to a plethora of social entrepreneurship ideas that they may choose to turn into startup businesses.
